Price List for Extra Food/ Beverage

Students are strongly encouraged to eat a school meal before they can purchase any ala carte item. Students who bring their lunch from home may purchase milk or menu items at the ala carte prices listed below listed below. Students must have either money in their accounts or cash in hand before an ala carte item can be purchased.

SCHOOL MEAL CHARGE POLICY—All students in grades preschool-12 shall be allowed to make prepayments to their individual school meal account. All students must have money in their accounts for the purchase of extra or a la carte items. Students attending CEP schools will eligible to receive a lunch and breakfast meal at no charge to them. Whereas Logan County High School students shall have the option to prepay, high school students may charge a maximum dollar amount of \$10.00. Parents will be notified once their student’s meal charges are \$2.00 or more via automated call system, In Touch.

INSUFFICIENT CHECK POLICY

All checks returned for insufficient funds to the School Food Service Program are subject to a \$25.00 service charge. After receipt of two checks returned for insufficient funds, the District Food Service Department will notify parents by mail that they will be required to make cash payments for meals for the remainder of the school year.

ADULT AND STUDENT VISITORS

Parents/guardians and other family members are welcome to eat lunch or breakfast with their student. ALL Visitor Meals are \$4.00 for lunch and \$3.00 for breakfast and will be CASH ONLY.
