

Dear Parents,

KUNA (Kentucky United Nations Assembly) – is a 3-day experience in Louisville that provides students with a greater appreciation for our global community through hands-on involvement with international issues and solutions. The conference is geared toward developing students' international consciousness through role-play as they represent one of the members of the United Nations!

Students participating in KUNA will go to Louisville to the KUNA conference on March 3-5, 2019. Students will ride the bus to Louisville on Sunday, March 3rd. We will be staying two nights at the Crowne Plaza Hotel. We will return to school by bus on Tuesday, March 5th at 1:00-2:00 PM. Students will be expected to stay at school until 2:55 (regular dismissal) on Tuesday.

For the conference, students will need business attire and casual clothing (see your KUNA list). Additionally, they will need a warm coat as we will be doing some outside walking to and from conference events. Also, please bring appropriate pajamas/nightwear for the hotel. The cost of the conference is \$250.00, which includes the hotel and some meals. Hopefully, with the students working events such as dances, and with financial scholarship, the student's final cost will be around \$190-220. Finally, they will need \$40-50 dollars for three meals and spending money.

This is a joint effort with Auburn School and the YMCA organization, so there are certain requirements that must be met in order to be in this class. The following must be met: A/B average, no discipline issues from the previous year, teacher recommendations, and be a positive role model for our school and community.

I have several students who are interested in this class, and unfortunately I do not have the space to accommodate all students for the conference. Returning this form and agreeing to pay the fee doesn't guarantee your child will be able to participate. If your child is accepted in the program, he/she will be notified.

If your student commits to this class, your student is committing to attending the conference and paying any difference between school funding and the conference cost.

There is a \$100 dollar NON-REFUNDABLE deposit due the first week after student is accepted to attend conference; all remaining balance must be paid before conference. If funding is a problem, please contact the school as soon as possible.
