Auburn Middle School Enrichment Class Syllabus

Class Description: STLP is a project oriented class where students can learn, showcase and expand their use of technology on school or community based projects. Students can attend WKU showcase at Diddle Arena during the fall semester to compete for invitations to the State STLP conference. The state competition is held at Rupp Arena in Lexington, Ky during late March or Early April. Showcase and other technology based competitions take place during the one day conference.

Goals/Objectives for the Class:

1. Students will learn different types of technology by research and knowledge sharing.
2. Students will learn leadership and group skills by working with other students.
3. Students will learn project development.

Strategies & Activities for the Class:

1. Students will choose a project to work on. Depending on other interests in the class, students may work alone or with a group.
2. Students will brainstorm and plan the project with help from teachers and/or group members.
3. Students will develop projects with a plan in mind. Students will reevaluate their plan from time to time to make sure they are on track and adjust for any changes.
4. As projects develop, students will share their information and help other students in class by sharing their knowledge of technology. They will also work with other groups to suggest improvements for other projects in the class.

How Students Will Be Evaluated: Student work will be evaluated based on quality of work, uniqueness/creativity, authenticity, and effort. For partner and small group projects, students will also be evaluated based on their efforts to work as a responsible partner/group member.
