

DRESS CODE

1. All students should be clean and neat in their dress and personal appearance so as not to be offensive to others.
2. All clothing or lack of clothing that is considered indecent or distracting will not be allowed.
 - a. No sagging (clothing worn below the hip bone)
 - b. No clothing that promotes alcohol, drugs, sex or violence
 - c. No clothing that exposes undergarments. No low cut shirts. Holes in jeans may be **no less than fingertip length (standing straight, fingers fully extended)** in grades 4-8.
 - d. Sleeveless shirts may be worn, but those with large armholes exposing underarm/chest area must be worn over a T-shirt or with a cover shirt in grades 4-8. Neither tank tops nor camisoles may be worn as the outer shirt.
 - e. No midriff tops which expose the stomach whether arms are raised or down.
 - f. All shorts and skirts are to be **no less than fingertip length (standing straight, fingers fully extended)** in grades 4-8.
 - g. Leggings must have an over garment **no less than fingertip length (standing straight, fingers fully extended)** in grades 4-8.
 - h. Pajamas/house slippers may not be worn unless it is a special school event (Pajama Day).
 - i. No hats or hoods may be worn on the head during school hours unless it is a special school event (Hat Day).

CONSEQUENCES

1ST Offense – Student will be given a written warning by teacher, and parents will be called to bring a change of clothes.

2nd Offense – Student will be given a written warning and sent to the office. Parents will be called to bring a change of clothes.*

3rd Offense – Student will be given a written warning and sent to the office. Parents will be called to bring clothes.* Student will spend one day in ISI.

4th Offense – Student will be given a written warning and sent to the office. Parents will be called to bring clothes.* Student will spend three days in ISI.

5th Offense – Student will be given a written warning and must wear strict dress code consisting of jeans and Olmstead shirt for a 9-week period.*

*If parents cannot be reached, cannot bring more clothes, or refuse to bring a change of clothes, the student will be sent to the FRYSC to get pants and a shirt to wear for the rest of the day. The inappropriate clothing will be returned to the student when the borrowed clothes are returned to school clean, pressed, and on a hanger.
